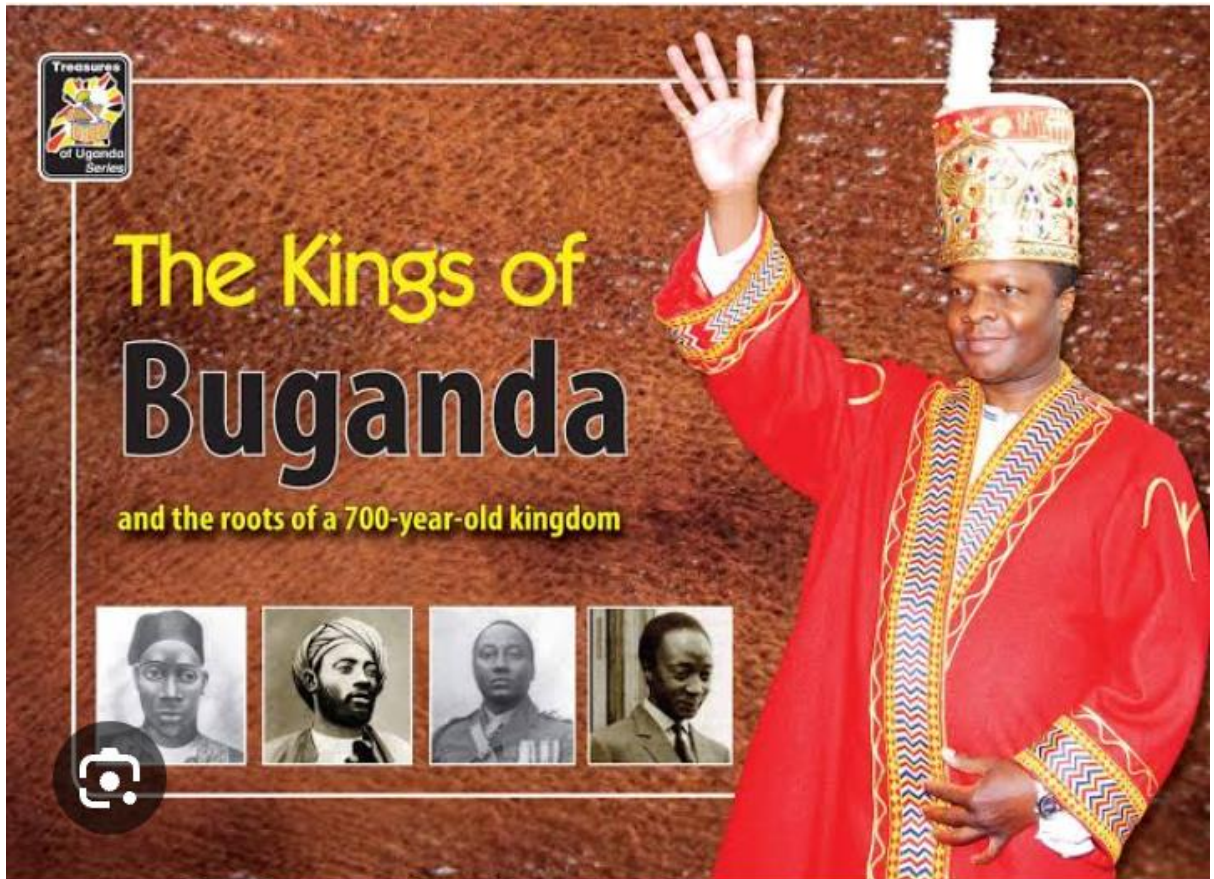
### **SECTION A:**

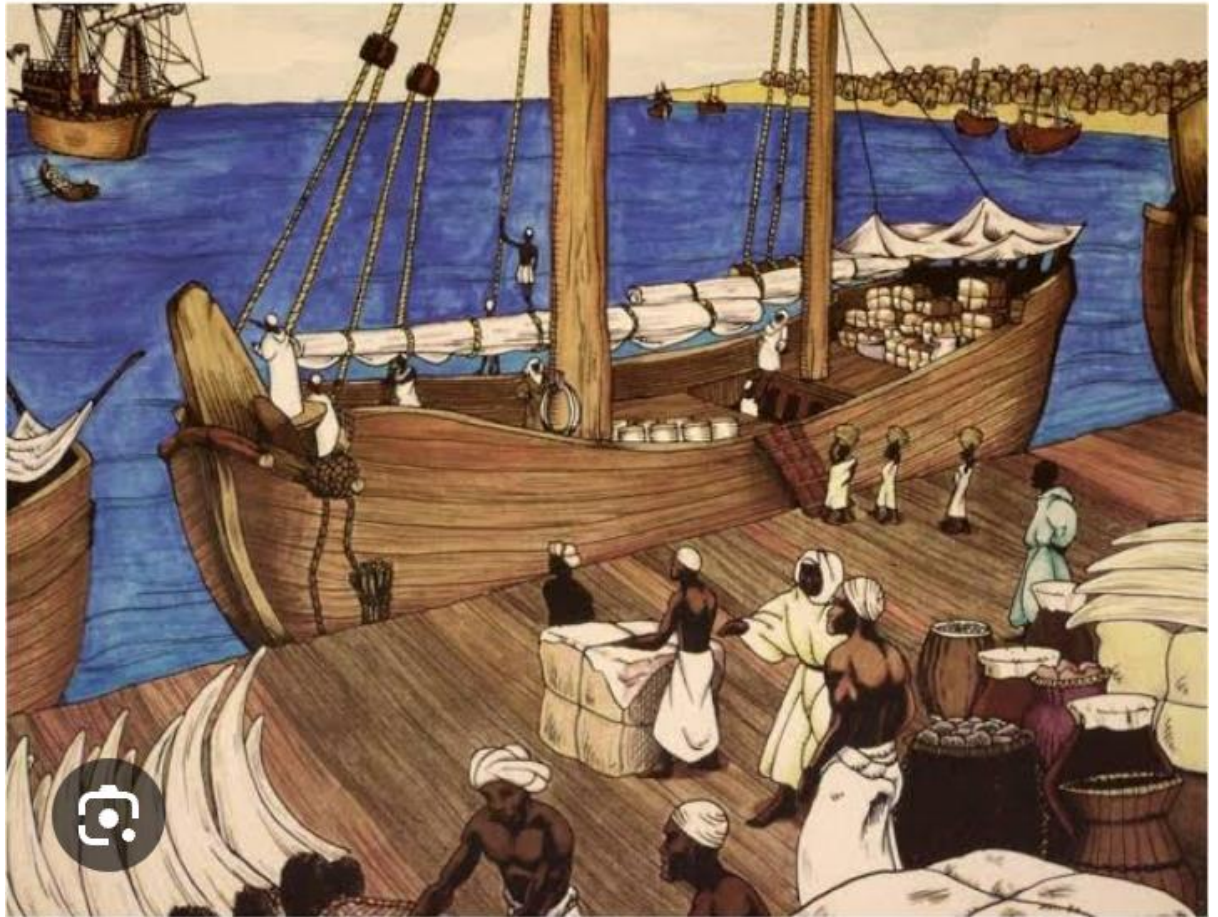
- (a) As a student of history and political education help such people by describing the political and economic organization of Buganda kingdom. (10mks)
