Item 1

- b) What were the outcomes for the scramble and partition of east Africa? **(07 scores)**

Item 2

By the 19th century, the Zanzibar Sultanate stood out for being the main slave market in eastern Africa due to its strategic location in the Indian ocean. It is estimated that between 1830 and 1873, around 600,000 people were sold as merchandise and thousands of other people visited the place temporarily.

Task

- a) Explain the methods that were used to acquire slaves. **(06 scores)**
- b) Show reasons why this trade was practiced by early years of 18th century. **(06 scores)**

Item 3

For over three decades, a number of people have moved to Uganda called migrants settling in different parts of the country including your community. Their coming has largely led to conflicts with the local people in the area they have settled. The local leaders of these areas have identified you to work with them to resolve this conflicts and encourage the natives to accommodate them.

Task

As a student of history and political education, write an essay explaining the effects of the migrants to the people of Uganda and give a resolution of what could be done to avoid this.

Item 4

The people in north eastern Uganda are faced with a lot of insecurity due to cattle rustling and land wrangles in the Karamojong region. Teso region and neighboring western Kenya. The government of Uganda has taken the step of involving the local people in these regions to help contain these conflicts.

Task

As the chief adviser to the minister of defense and security of Uganda, write a report on the consequences of this conflicts for the communities.
