**Item 1**

## Item 4

The current Kibaale district in Bunyoro sub-region was originally occupied by the Banyoro and it was sparsely populated on fertile soil. This encouraged the Bakiga who had limited land in Kabale and Rukungili, to start migrating into these areas. Today the Bakiga are higher in number than the original Banyoro. This has caused tribal competition for most resources available in Kibaale district.

### Task

- (a) Why did the Bakiga migrate from their homeland? (10 scores)
- (b) How have the Banyoro affected y the migration of the Bakiga to their area? (10 scores)

### **Item 5**

A section of people of Maya village are against activities of Christian Religious group from Germany. They petitioned the local government of the area to block its operations in their community citing challenges like noise pollution fraud by pastors and spread of gay related activities among others. However, majority of the people in the area of the view that despite the above challenges, religion plays a significant role in the development of the community as such, the Christian group should be left to carry out their activities.

Write an essay to convince the people in Maya to welcome the activities of the Christian groups.
