SECTION A

Item 1

On 1st March 2010, landslides occurred in the district of Bududa in eastern Uganda. The landslide was started by heavy rain on that day. At least 100 people were believed to have been killed. There was destruction of property as a result of landslides, in which over 150 houses were destroyed. In 2019, the government started resettling the survivors of the 2010 landslides to resettlement areas. Those who have not moved were advised to leave the dangerous locations to less risky.

Task.

- (a) How will the future generation (100 years or more) born in the resettlement areas know and trace the history of their relatives. (10 scores)
- (b) Discuss the evidence that will be relied upon to show that people once lived in those areas they relocated from?

Item 2

In one of the E.A.C, investors have received land from the government to build factories. However, the land includes several local cultural and historical sites that have been significant to our town. The government is finalizing plans to evict the residents in these areas, but many oppose this move. These cultural sites face the risk of demolition to make room for new commercial development. You have been assigned the task of helping to preserve these sites from being destroyed.

Task.

- (a) Write an essay sensitizing the authorities about the sites' importance that can help to protect the above. (20 scores)

Item 3

Item 4
